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

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ABSTRAK

Kajian ini bertujuan untuk menyediakan suatu platform atau sistem yang cepat dan mudah berkaitan tentang masalah tertentu yang dihadapi oleh para pelajar di Universiti Utara Malaysia. Dengan adanya sistem ini, para pelajar yang menghadapi sebarang masalah tidak perlu lagi berjumpa kaunselor secara bersemuka. Pendekatan yang digunakan dalam kajian ini adalah pendekatan dalam bentuk penyelesaian masalah dan turut menyentuh konsep elektronik kaunseling. CHAPTER 1
